ASSOCIATE MEMBER CATEGORY AND DUES

- Associate membership is divided into six categories (see below).
- Membership dues are payable annually. The fiscal year of WAPA begins January 1.
- There is no initiation fee, but annual dues are payable *in advance* and must be received before membership is proposed/approved by the WAPA Board of Directors.
- Members joining after July 1 will be assessed 50% of the annual dues. Thereafter, the Associate member invoice for annual dues will be issued on a full year basis at the beginning of the year.
- Each Associate member has one vote on the Associate Members' Council.
- The Associate members' Council will elect a Chair who will serve for two years.
- The Associate members' Council Chair will have one voting seat on the WAPA Board of Directors as the representative of the Associate members.
- Membership dues include sponsorship of Annual and Mid-year WAPA social functions. Any supplemental sponsorship opportunities are entirely optional.
